

Requirements to become a DJ:

1) 6+ hours of shadowing

- 1 Shadowing sessions will be offered Monday-Wednesday from 7pm-Midnight for three weeks. Djs will be on air for you to watch and learn. Make sure you pay close attention and ask questions because this WILL come in handy later. You are required to attend at least 6 hours of Shadowing. When you attend a shadowing session, MAKE SURE THE DJ SIGNS YOUR SHEET BEFORE YOU LEAVE. Other wise you WILL NOT receive credit.
- 2 We will also be hosting a “night class” on Wednesday September 12th from 7pm-8pm. The “night class” is not mandatory, but if attended, you will get 1 hour of shadowing credit. We will be going over the handbook in depth and we will answer any questions you have up until this point. It is highly recommended that you attend, but not mandatory.
- 3 Shadowing sign-off sheets will be posted on our website. You must hand them in before your test.

2) Air Check

- 1 You will sign up for a fifteen minute slot for you to be tested on your on air capabilities. This will include being able to work the board, play songs, do proper breaks, and do it all somewhat fluently.
- 2 An e-board member will be in the studio with you grading your performance
- 3 The checklists will be posted online for you guys to check out prior to your actual air check.

3) Test

- 1 There is 35 question test. All the material from the questions can be located in the Handbook (which is posted on our website). It is a combinations of short answer and multiple choice.
- 2 You MUST answer at least 26 right (that means you can get up to 9 wrong). There are no re-takes.
